

2008 Block of the Month (BOM)

“Sunshine and Shadow Birds”

Log cabin Cutting Instructions (finish block size 9½” x 9½”).
48 blocks is the sunshine and shadow blocks and 32 border blocks (optional).

Center Squares

2 strips of red 1½ inch wide Cut into 48 squares 1½ inch.

Background (B1, B2, B3 and B4), use assorted lights

Scraps of lights of the following

B1 - 1½” x 1½” and 1½” x 2½”,

B2 - 1½” x 3½” and 1½” x 4½”,

B3 - 1½” x 5½” and 1½” x 6½”,

B4 - 1½” x 7½” and 1½” x 8½”.

Assorted Darks (D1,D2, D3 and D4)

Scraps of Darks of the following

D1 - 1½” x 2½” and 1½” x 3½”,

D2 - 1½” x 4½” and 1½” x 5½”,

D3 - 1½” x 6½” and 1½” x 7½”,

D4 - 1½” x 8½” and 1½” x 9½”.

Each Bird Block need 4 log cabin blocks (18½” x 18½”), setting each block as sunshine and shadow traditional log cabin, then appliqué the bird last.

I sew 4 blocks at the time in order to save time!

Once all the bird blocks are done, then I would add the borders (32 blocks) last.
